It's been 6 weeks since we were called to a home where four puppies and their parents were abandoned. When we got there the puppies were in horrific condition and so was their mother. We found out that they were days if not hours from death. These pups were so weak they weren't able to move or play. Their bodies were damaged from the lack of nutrition. We really weren't sure what the outcome was going to be for them.

Today all four puppies are a healthy weight, they have overcome several medical issues, and they love to run and play. Their immune systems haven't fully recovered from the trauma and there may be some long lasting effects down the road. But these puppies (Continues on page 2)
